

Backyard Chicken Farming



Description:

A chicken coop is a small house where, typically, female chickens or other fowl are kept safe and secure. There are nest boxes found inside the hen house for egg-laying, and perches on which the birds can sleep. Our chicken coop has connected tunnels for chickens to run around the garden. Inside, the chicken coop has an automatic chicken feeder and waterer. The feeder is DIY, made of a transparent container and has two openings to facilitate feeding for chickens. The waterer is made of pipe and connected with chicken nipples for chickens to drink from. The chicken coop that is up at the Eco Home is a mix of Eco- Luxe and DIY. We bought a chicken coop online, but it didn't have enough room for a hatchery, we added an extension for a hatchery and more space for the chickens. A basic Eco- Luxe chicken coop will take only about 20 minutes to assemble (without electric door).
